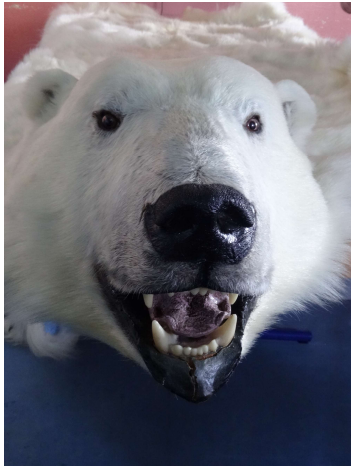

Bear head

brooch or earring ?



You need :

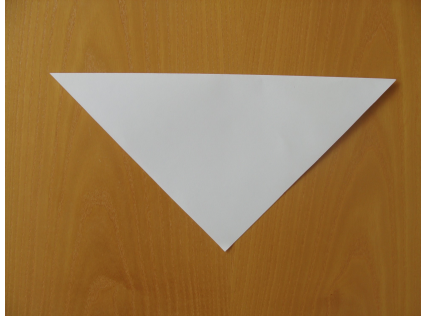
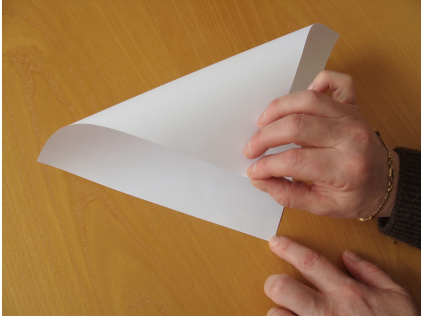
- white sheet of paper
- des épingles à broche
- earring
- glue for jewel
- ruler, scissors
- 1 black marker , 1 pin



***For the brooches,
cut squares of
4 cm sides.***

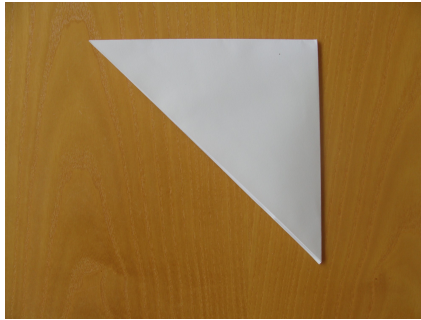
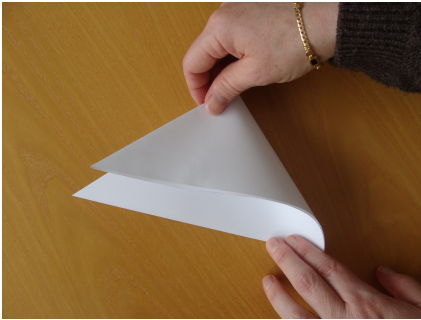


***For the earrings
cut squares of
2 cm sides.***

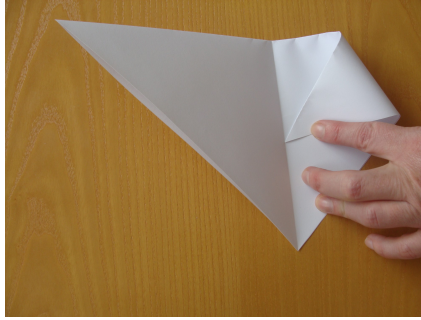
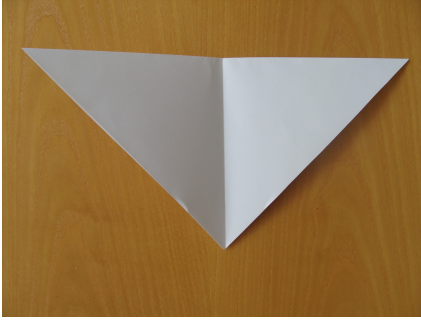


First, we try with a big square ... Take a sheet of 20 X 20 cm square !

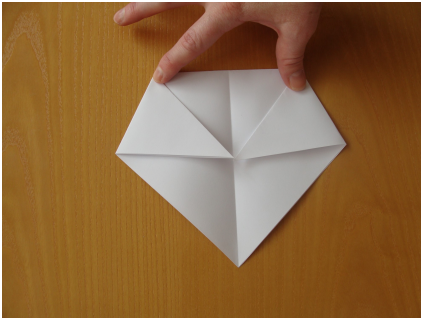
Fold the square in half to make a triangle.



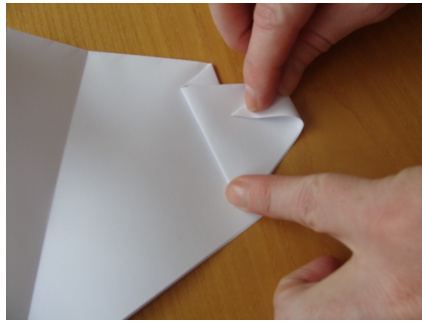
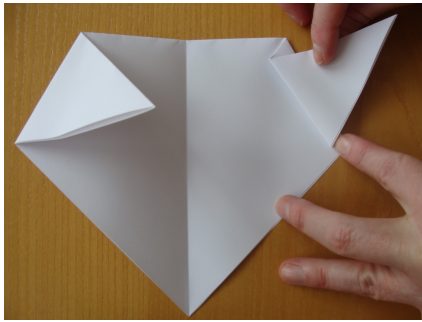
Then fold the triangle in half as shown in the picture . . .



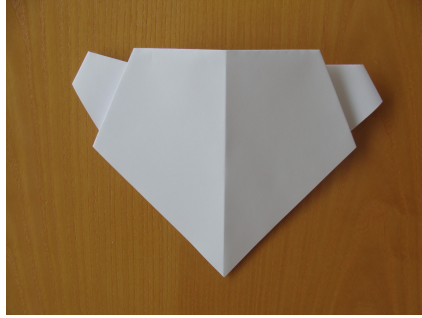
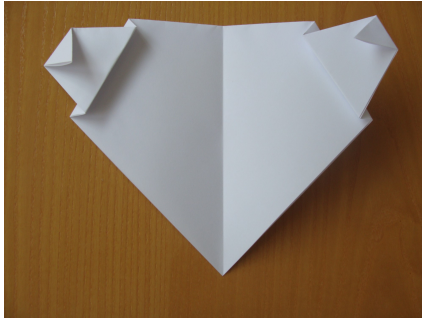
*Open the last fold . . . the center fold is well marked !
Bring the upper right corner in the middle of the center fold.*



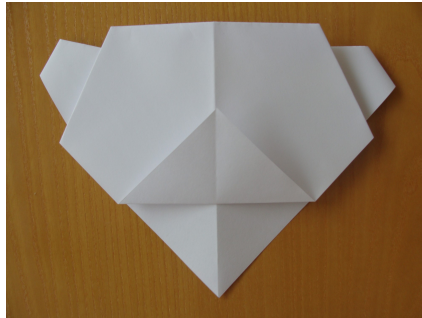
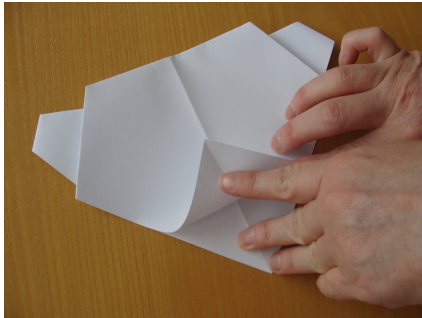
Do the same with the upper left corner . . .



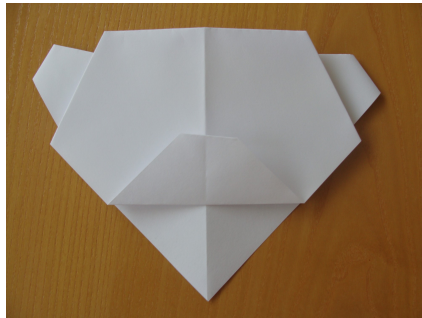
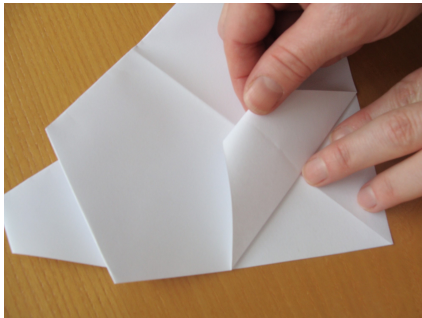
*For folding the ears,
look carefully at the 3
first pictures and do the
same . . .*



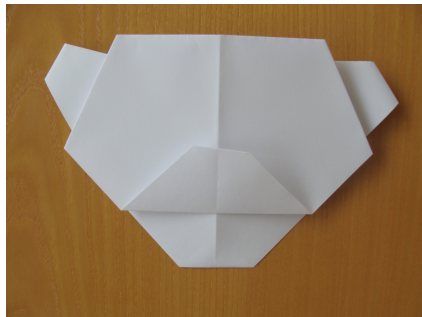
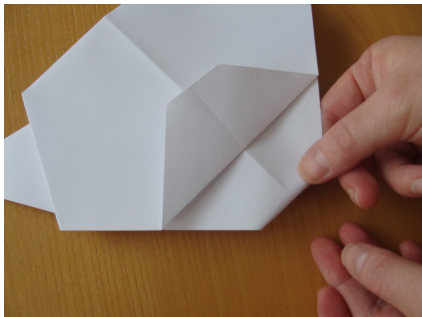
*Then turn the folding
over !!!*



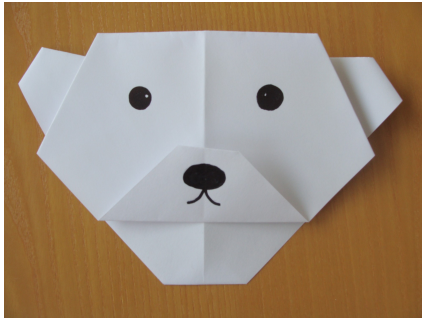
*Fold the lower edge
of the first sheet
up to the nose level . . .*



*Fold the tip towards the
inside !*

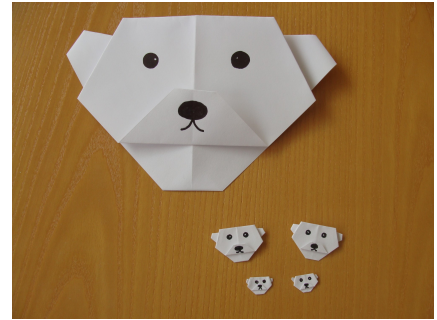


*Fold the tip of the
second sheet
backwards . . .*



Then draw the eyes and the nose !

*Do the same folding on the small little squares
of 2 X 2 cm and 4 X 4 cm sides !!!*



*Glue the brooch
at the back of the bear's head (4cm)*

*Pinch between fingers . . . and,
if necessary, use a clothespin !*



Using a pin, make a hole in the small bear's head (2 cm).

Put a ring in the hole . . . and attach it to the earring . . .

Work carefully in order not to tear the head !!!
