

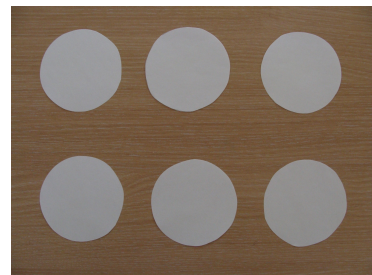
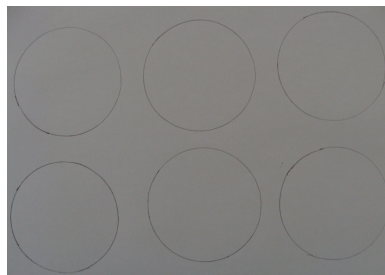
Snowballs ... for polar decoration (for all)



*In order to create a polar atmosphere,
hanging snowballs on the Christmas tree
or elsewhere throughout the house . . .*

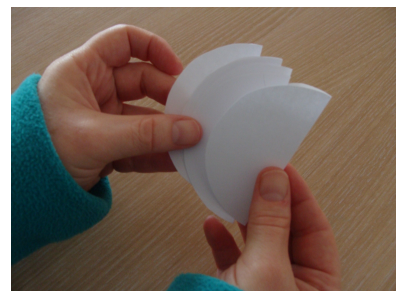
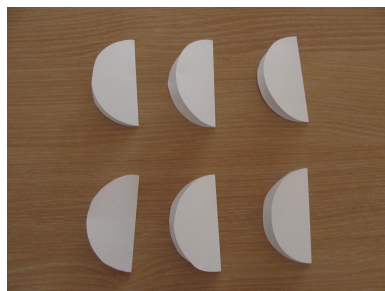
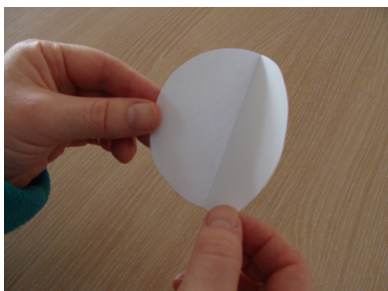
You need :

- 1 sheet of paper, pieces of yarn
- 1 pencil, scissors, 1 stapler
- 1 cup to go round or 1 compass



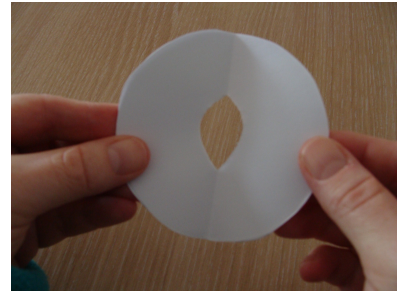
*On a white sheet of paper,
go round a cup or use a compass to draw 6 equal circles.*

cut them out . . .

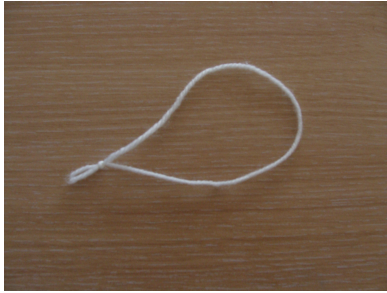


Fold each circle in half . . .

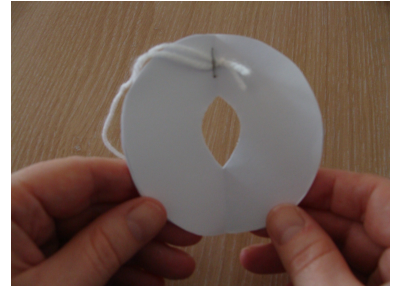
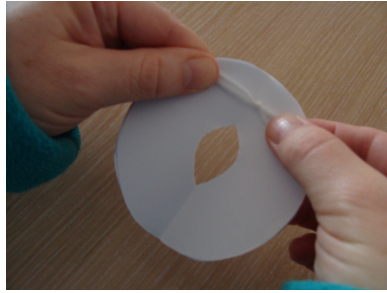
Then put them into each other as shown on the picture.



Through all layers, cut a little circle in the middle of the fold . . .



Take a piece of yarn and tie the 2 ends with a knot.



*Now staple the yarn onto the circle, through all the layers at the center fold . . .
The staple will hold the knot from moving and allowing you to hang your snowball where you wish !*



Open the sheets and pinch the folds open, 3 in one direction and 3 in the other . . .

You have a snowball to hang !



If you cut some points on the outside of the circle of the snowball . . .

You'll have

a snowstar to hang!
