- Tape and scissors





Open the book that you want to cover . . .

Fold the bottom of the paper inside of the book covers and do the same for the top of the book. . . cutting + folding!!!

As seen in the 3rd picture!





For the sides, fold the corners as shown in the picture . . .





Then fold the flap inwards

Use tape to hold the corners together . . .



The hardest thing is done!

The book is covered . . .

Soon it will be a bear!
