(10 - 12 years old)



Carriers of tealights,

these polar bears


will brighten the night

and decorate the party tables!!!



You need:

- plaster,
- tealights,
- glue, scotch tape,
- scissors, 1 black marker,
- white paper to print,
- recycled cardboard



To print the pattern, see on the previous page

Cut the bears out

and glue them on the cardboard...





Out of a sheet $8 \ 1/2 \ X \ 11$, cut $2 \ long \ strips \ of +/- \ 3 \ cm \ high . . .$ Tape these strips as shown in the picture, using little pieces of scotch tape.

It's a delicate process requiring patience!





Prepare the plaster as directed on the package... then pour it into the mold.





Move slightly the mold to spread out the plaster everywhere.
Smooth the surface making it even.
Push the tealight in the middel . . .

Then let dry!!!





When the plaster
is almost dry,
tear the mold and
remove the tealight!
With your fingers,
remove the paper
which sticks to the
plaster.

With a small knife, cut the edges to make even . . .





When the plaster is completely dry, draw the eye and the nose!!!

When it is dark . . .

Warm polar atmosphere guaranteed!!!
