
Recycling. . . Useful Bears for Storage! (for all)







THESE POLAR BEARS USEFUL FOR STORAGE!!! Use them on your desk, in the kitchen or on a shelf . . .



You will need:

- empty cartons from milk,
- juice, soup ...
- a sheet of white paper to print onto
- 1 black marker
- ruler, scissors, pencil
- glue and tape





Using scissors, cut halfway up 3 sides of the box ... Look at the pictures!





Take off the rest of the box but keep the entire fourth side . . .







Look at the pictures!!! Then cut the 2 bear's ears out of the long side of the box.








Measure the height of the box without the ears.

Place the white sheet of paper horizontally . . .

Carefully cut out a strip of the measured height.







Roll the strip around the box.

Tape it on the side where the ears are . . .

It doesn't matter if the strip is too small!

Trace the face with the ears on the rest of the white paper.

Cut out the traced shapes.







Using a black marker, draw the ears, the eyes, the muzzle and the mouth.

Glue your drawing on the side of the box which has the ears. Use glue.

Your polar bear is ready for storage!
