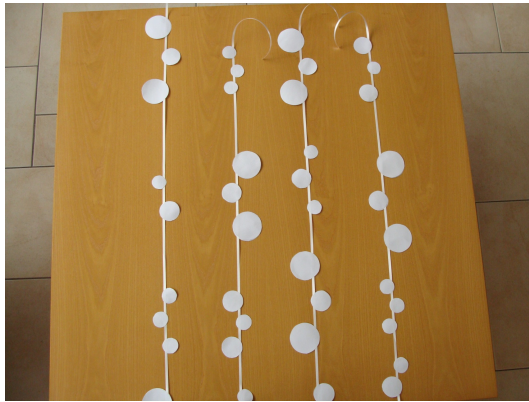


Using only circles . . .
polar decoration for windows ! (8-12 years old)

A lot of snowflakes . . .
to give windows a feast polar look !!!

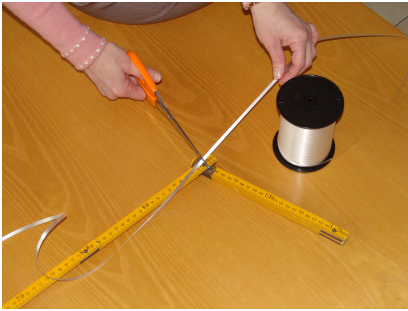


You need :

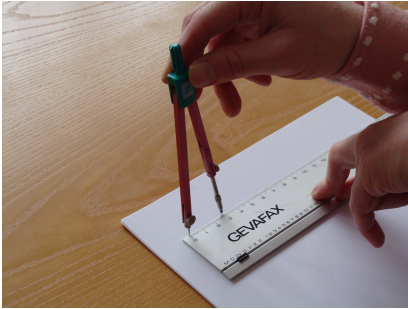
- white paper
- white gift ribbon
- a meter, a ruler
- a compass
- scissors, glue, tape

*. . . ask an adult for help
to measure
the window's height to decorate.*





Cut long pieces of white gift ribbon the same size as the window's height.



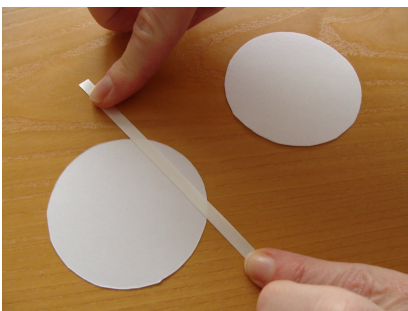
*Then, using your compass, trace a lot of circles on the white paper :
some tall-sized (6cm in diameter),
some medium-sized (4cm in diameter)
and some small-sized (3 cm in diameter)*



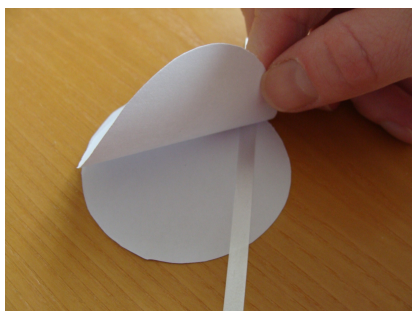
Then cut out all the circles !



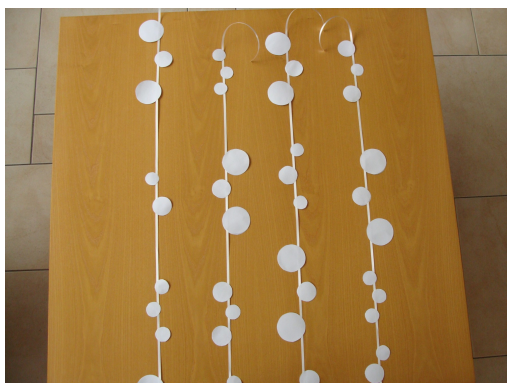
Choose 2 circles having the same size and glue them.



Then put the gift ribbon at the edge of one circle.



*Carefully return
the other circle on the first one.
So the string is between them.*



*Glue 2 or 3 snowflakes
then leave a piece of ribbon without anything.
Then begin again . . .*



*Then using tape . . .
hang your decorations up in the window !*

*To balance the gift ribbon, glue one snowflake on the right side,
then the next one on the left side, alternating the pattern !*

!!! Mix the different snowflakes sizes as you like !!!
