Surprise your friends by making one with scoubidou !

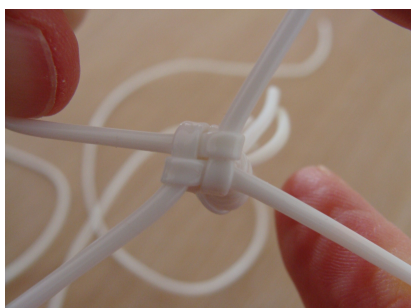
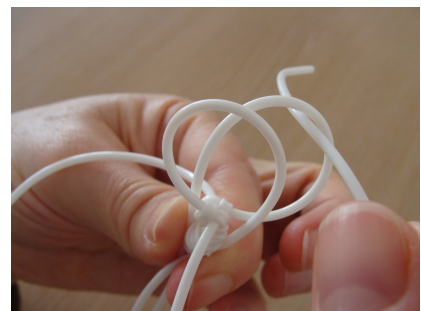
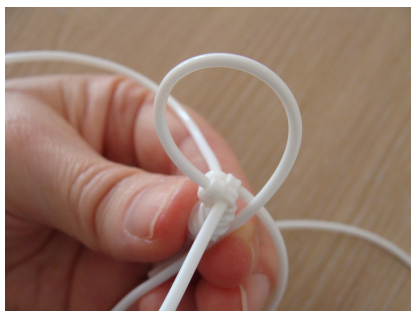


You need :

- white scoubidou wires (+/- 85 cm)
- brown beads
- very strong glue, scissors, 1 pencil
- 1 brown sheet of paper or a white sheet and color pencils or paint



Tie together 4 scoubidou wires . . .

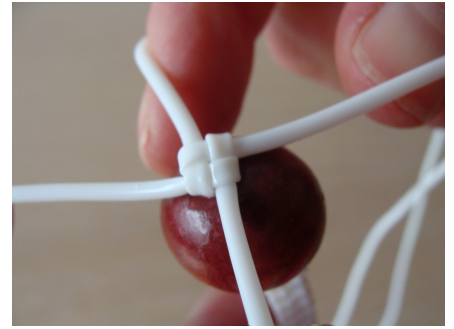
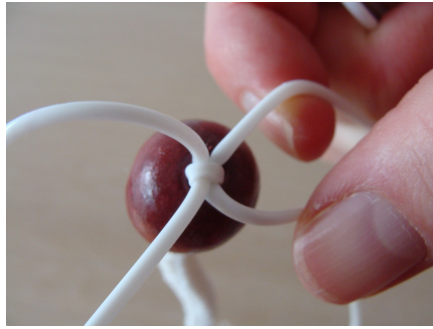


*Make more or less 10 rows of scoubidou ...
as shown on the pictures.*

If necessary, you can find videos on Youtube !



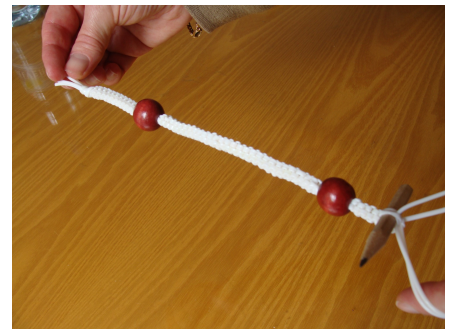
*Put on a brown bead . . .
and pass the 4 wires
through it !!!*



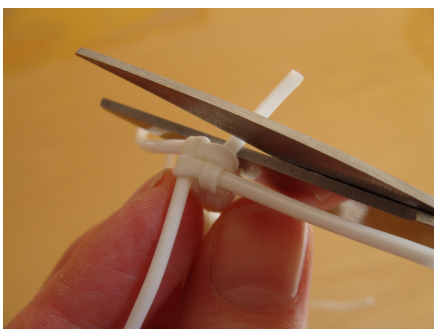
*Then tie 2 wires in order to tighten the bead . . .
and make more scoubidou rows !!!*



*After +/-20 -25 additional
rows, put on another brown
bead in the same way that
you put the first one . .
Then make more
6 scoubidou rows !*



*Then put a pencil as shown on the picture.
Tight it by knotting wires 2 by 2 !!!
When you take the pencil off,
you'll obtain a kind of "button hole" . . .*



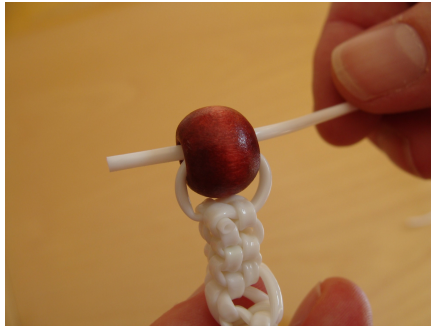
Add another 4 or 5 rows . . .

*To end, put a glue point on the last row of the
scoubidou.*

Let it dry then cut 2 wires.



*There are 2 wires left . . .
Pass 1 of them in a bead . . .*

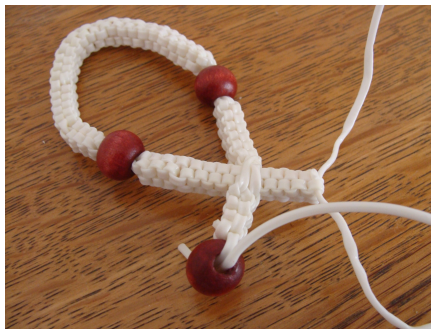
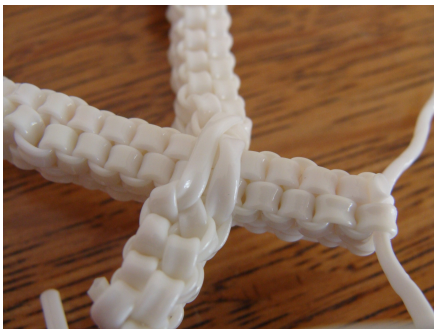


*Then pass the other in
the opposite direction . . .*



Put a glue point . . .

Let it dry . . . Then cut the pieces of wire that exceed !



Untied the knot from the beginning and take the pencil off ...

Pass the end without bead through the "button hole" as shown on the picture.

End this side in the same way you ended the other side.



*Click on the previous page to print the pattern
of the head*

then glue it on the scoubidou with strong glue !!!

Be creative

!!! Mix the colors !!!

and create other "grolar" . . . All is permitted !!!

Brown scoubidou, white head, white and brown beads . . .
