

Learn to draw an orca




<u>Méthod</u>:

Put your finger on the screen several times to capture the movement.

Then try to reproduce it on a sheet of paper. Try several times to add the next line.







Be patient, put your finger on the lines several times wich are on the screen and then try to draw them from memory.

When the movement is well in your hand, take a pencil and a sheet.

Don't hesitate, your line has to be in one movement.


Start again untill you are satisfied with the result.






Do the same with the inside lines. Each drawing shows you one line wich you have to make in one movement without a cut.

You have almost succeeded, only the eye is missing.





Draw the eye, then color the orca in black like on the model.

Great! Your drawing looks almost like the original, but one little thing is still missing . . .





With a light grey pencil, color the central zone.

Leave the eye and the stomach in white.

You can draw the orca in different positions for entertainment.

Put its head down when it dives!
