

"The Visitors" ... Inuit string puzzle (for all)

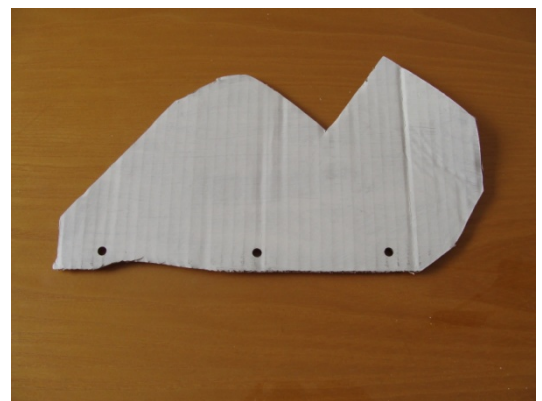


To make the puzzle you need :

- recycled cardboard, paint,
1 m (about 40 inches) of string or yarn,
- scissors, 1 hole punch, 1 paint brush,
1 pencil, 1 black marker

Out of the recycled cardboard, cut the shape of an iceberg. Paint the iceberg white on both sides.

Then, using a hole punch, make 3 holes as shown on the picture . . .



To print the pattern of the seal (see on the previous page). . .



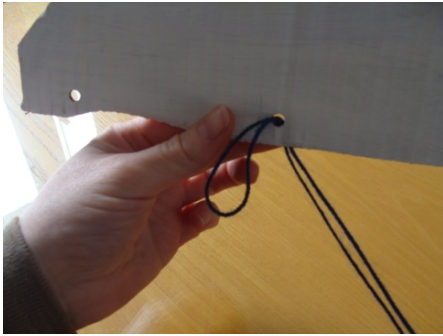
Cut out the pattern and trace around it 4 times on a grey recycled cardboard ...

!!! twice in each direction !!! ...

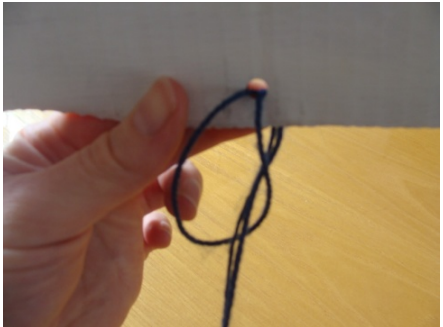
Cut out your 4 drawings and glue them back to back in order to obtain 2 thick seals

Using the hole punch, make a hole in their head ...

Then, draw eyes, whiskers, flipper and neck folds.



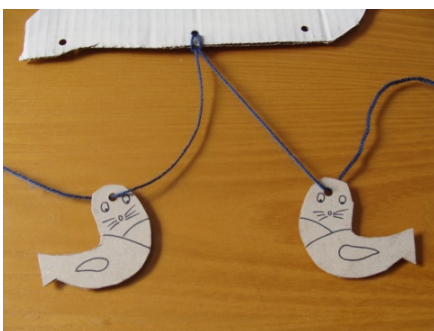
Take the piece of yarn (+/- 1 meter long) . . .
and fold it in half .



Pass the loop of yarn through the center hole
of the iceberg as shown on the picture.



Then slide the 2 pieces of yarn that hang
through the loop and pull . . .



Put a seal on each string.
Then attach the string to the hole above with
a knot (as shown in the picture).



The object of the puzzle is to have both seals
on the same string ...

KEEP TRYING ! It's difficult !
