## Walrus ... name holder (6-8 years old)



To find his place at the table ...

put a name holder walrus

on each plate!

Material

I thick sheet of brown or white paper recycled cardboard scissors, glue, a black marker, something to color.








To print the pattern see on the previous page


Stick the sheet with the drawing on the recycled cardboard and cut out the 2 forms.

So you obtain a template which will allow you

to make a lot of walrus.







Using a pencil, trace around the body's template on a thick brown sheet of paper or on a white sheet if you prefer color.

Cut your drawing carefully.

Then, fold in 2 parts the traced form, like on the picture.





Do the same with the snouth's template but choose a paper with a pale color (ivory, white, beige, light yellow)







Stick the snout on the body then draw the eyes.

Then color the dark brown circle and mark the outline with a black marker, like on the picture.

End drawing the points where the whiskers go out of.



Using your best writing,
note down your friend's name
above the walrus' paws.

Be inventive !!!

Play with the colors and match the walrus to the tablecloth.
