For Christmas ...


a polar decoration

Material

I white sheet of paper to print a thin piece of recycled cardboard a punch, scissors, glue, a pin, a piece of string something to color.



To print the pattern, see on the previous page

Cut out each piece then stick them on the thin cardboard in order to make them more solid.

Then color them in 2 brown shades, then cut the cardboard.

Use brown paper if you don't like color!








With a pin, pierce a hole in the 4 forms which represent the paws.







Cut 4 string pieces around 10 cm in lenght and make just one knot at the end of each of them.





With the string, tie the paws to the reindeer's body.

Make a knot at the back and adjust the length like on the picture.

Ask for an adult's help if it's too complicated.



For the eyes,
use circles
made with the punch.

A black line will give
them life.



For the snout, stick on a dark brown circle.

Stick the head to the body, slightly leaning!

Cut a string piece around 20 cm in lenght and make a knot.



Then ask an adult to help you to tie the string to the reindeer's head.



The more reindeer you make,

the more beautiful

the Christmas tree will be!
